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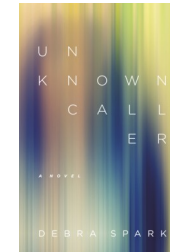
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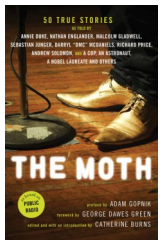


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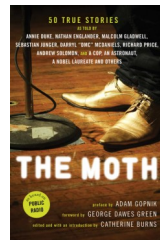

*The Moth: 50 True Stories* by Multiple Maine Authors

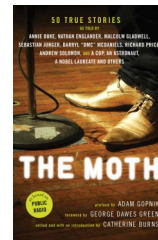
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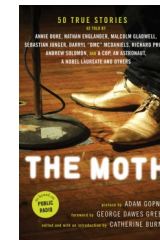

by Margaret Atwood

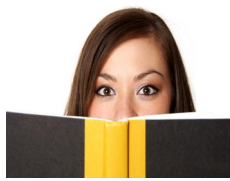
In a future world where the birth rate has declined, fertile women are rounded up, indoctrinated as "handmaids" and forced to bear children to prominent men.

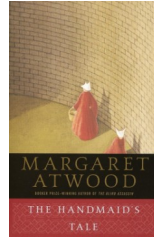
*The Last Painting of Sara de Vos*

Parallel narratives unfold and eventually converge in this multi-layered novel, which explores the legacy of fictional 17th-century Dutch painter Sara de Vos.



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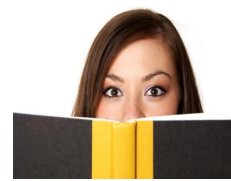
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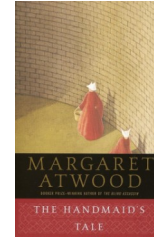
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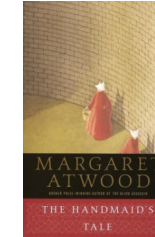
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
